## Executive Summary

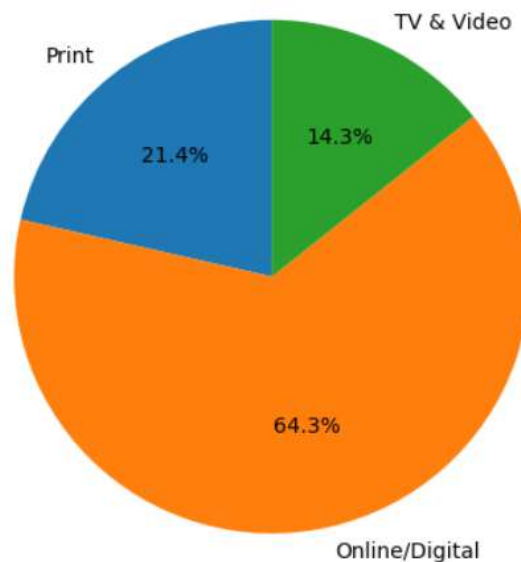
During the reporting period, the Flag Foundation of India (FFOI) received extensive and positive media coverage across print, digital, television, and social media platforms. Coverage focused on three major narratives:

1. The installation of the **200th Monumental National Flag at Kangla Fort, Manipur**
2. The proposal to designate **23 January as 'National Flag Day'**
3. The Foundation's **celebrations and felicitation of the Indian Women's Blind Cricket World Champions**

## Media Coverage Overview

The balanced media coverage saw a strong multi-platform presence and broad audience reach. Online and digital media account for the largest share of coverage, driven by PTI, ANI and IANS stories along with TOI Online, HT online and Indian Express online coverage. Print media contributes a significant portion with a mix of news and feature stories and edit articles in Hindu, Hindustan Times, Free Press Journal. High-impact visual amplification through broadcast and digital video formats was done by coverage on Doordarshan, Aajtak, Express Cafe.

### Guv, follow the Constitution

**G**overnors are appointed by the President on the advice of the Union government, but the Constitution does not amount them as political overseers of elected state governments. They are meant to be impartial constitutional authorities, not extensions of the ruling party at the centre. Yet, in recent years, the conduct of several governors has betrayed a disturbing pattern: activism against opposition-ruled states and docile silence when the Bharatiya Janata Party is in power. The latest flashpoints in Kerala, Tamil Nadu, and Karnataka underline a growing constitutional malaise. Governors Rajendra Vishwanath Arlekar in Kerala, R.N. Ravi in Tamil Nadu, and Thiruvarth Chandrababu in Karnataka have all abetted, transacted or refused to read portions of the Governor's Address—a speech drafted and approved by the elected Council of Ministers. This address is not a personal statement by the governor. It is a formal constitutional ritual that sets out the government's policies. To tamper with it is to challenge the authority of the elected executive.

What is striking is the selective nature of these objections. Paragraphs critical of the Union government—on financial devolution, MGNREGS, or policy failures—are deemed “involving” or “imappropriate”. Praise for central schemes, however, seldom attracts such constitutional scruples. In Tamil Nadu, Governor Ravi remained docile over

## A key battle fought to secure the right to fly the Tiranga

The coincidence of Jan 23 as both Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's birth anniversary and date of flag judgement adds a deeper layer of meaning

**E**very year on January 23, India commemorates the birth anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, a towering figure of courage and uncompromising nationalism. Less remembered, but equally significant for India's democratic life, is that the same date marks a landmark judicial moment in 2004 when the Supreme Court affirmed the right of every Indian citizen to hoist the national flag—the Tiranga—on any day, provided it is done with dignity and respect. This ruling transformed the flag from a tightly controlled state emblem into a living symbol of personal liberty and collective pride. It was quiet but profound expansion of citizenship, restoring to ordinary Indians a right that should never have been denied in the first place.

Before this judgement, the right to fly the national flag was not considered fundamental. The Flag Code of India, an executive document framed in the early years after independence, imposed strict limitations on the display of the Tiranga. Its use was largely confined to government buildings and specific national days such as Independence Day, Republic Day, and Gandhi Jayanti. Private citizens were discouraged—and often prevented—from

hoisting the flag at their homes, workplaces, or institutions.

The consequences of this restrictive approach were far from symbolic alone. The flag, which had once been carried into protests, prisons, and mass movements during the freedom struggle, was rendered distant from everyday life. Instead of being a unifying presence, it became a regulated object, accessible only with official sanction. Patriotism, in effect, was rationed. This distance between democratic aspiration and administrative control revealed a deeper discomfort with individual expressions of national identity.

It was this contradiction that prompted industrialist Naveen Jindal to challenge the prevailing orthodoxy. In 1992, Jindal hoisted the Tiranga at his factory premises in Raigarh, Chhattisgarh. Local authorities swiftly intervened, citing violations of the Flag Code. Rather than accepting the restriction, Jindal chose to contest it, asking a fundamental question: in an independent republic, why should citizens require permission to display their own national flag?

Jindal's conviction was shaped by both principle and compulsion. In many democracies across the world, national flags are freely displayed by citizens as everyday af-

firmations of belonging. To him, the Tiranga was not a fragile artefact requiring excessive protection but a resilient symbol meant to inspire unity across religious, class, and ideology. His insistence was never about casual or commercial use; it was about dignified visibility and constitutional entitlement.

The legal battle formally began in 1995, when Jindal approached the Delhi High Court. His argument was precise: the Flag Code did not have the force of law as it was not enacted by Parliament, and therefore, could not override fundamental rights guaranteed by the Constitution. More importantly, he contended that hoisting the national flag was a form of expression protected under Article 19(1)(a), which guarantees freedom of speech and expression.

The High Court accepted this reasoning, holding that executive instructions could not curtail constitutional freedoms. The central government appealed the decision, pushing the matter to the Supreme Court. What followed was nearly a decade of legal deliberation, marked by concerns about potential misuse of the flag and the need to preserve its sanctity. These anxieties reflected a long-standing fear: that loosening control would lead to disrespect. Yet, they also underestimated the public's capacity for responsible pa-

triotism. On January 23, 2004, the Supreme Court delivered a nuanced and historic judgement. It affirmed that the right to hoist the national flag is indeed a facet of freedom of expression under Article 19(1)(a). The act of flying the Tiranga, the Court observed, conveys allegiance, pride, and affection for the nation. At the same time, the Court clarified that the right was not absolute. Reasonable restrictions under Article 19(2)—relating to public order, decency, morality, and integrity of the nation—would continue to apply to prevent disrespect or misuse.

This balance was the ruling's greatest strength. It neither invalidated the flag nor elevated it beyond democratic reach. Instead, it located national symbolism firmly within constitutional morality. The judgement also exposed an uncomfortable truth: more than five decades after independence, Indians had needed judicial intervention to reclaim a basic expression of patriotism. That alone was an indictment of excessive state paternalism.

The impact of the verdict was immediate and enduring. The Flag Code was amended to reflect the Court's ruling, easing restrictions and affirming citizens' rights. Across the country, the Tiranga began appearing more frequently at homes, institutions, and public spaces—not

as a mandated display, but as a voluntary expression of belonging. Patriotism became participatory rather than ceremonial.

Jindal's role in this transformation stands out not merely because he was an industrialist, but because he pressed the issue as a civic cause rather than a personal grievance. Through the Flag Foundation of India, he has continued to advocate for greater awareness of citizens' rights related to the national flag and has promoted January 23 as National Flag Day in recognition of the SC verdict. While this date has not yet been officially designated as such, the idea has gained symbolic resonance. The coincidence of January 23 as both Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's birth anniversary

observed as Parakram Diwas, and the date of the flag judgement adds a deeper layer of meaning. Both moments speak of courage—one in defying colonial rule, the other in questioning inherited constraints within a free nation. Together, they remind us that independence is not a static achievement but a continuous process of reclaiming rights and redefining citizenship.

**Flag Foundation of India marks 200th monumental flag installation; proposes Jan 23rd as 'National Flag Day'**



Marking a historic convergence of heritage and patriotism, the Flag Foundation of India (FFOI) today installed its 200th monumental national flag at the historic Kangla Fort in Imphal. The installation serves as the centrepiece of a dual anniversary: 30 years since the landmark Delhi High Court judgment and 22 years since the Supreme Court of India recognized flying the National Flag as a protected fundamental freedom under Article 19(1)(a), subject to constitutional guidelines. The choice of Kangla Fort for the 200th installation is deeply symbolic, as Manipur attained its Statehood in 1972 on 21st Jan. As the ancient seat of Manipur's monarchs and a spiritual heart for the Meitei identity, the Fort now hosts the Tricolour as a beacon of national unity. This installation ensures that the thousands of tourists and locals who visit the site daily are met with a towering reminder of India's shared democratic values.

Today's celebrations honour the perseverance of Mr Naveen Jindal, Founder and President of FFOI. Upon returning to India from the United States, Mr. Jindal challenged the then-restrictive Flag Code of India, which prohibited private citizens from flying the flag except on specific holidays. His decade-long legal crusade resulted in the Supreme Court's historic January 23, 2004, ruling, which declared that flying the Tiranga with dignity is a form of "freedom of expression" under Article 19(1)(a) of the Indian Constitution.

"The Tricolour is a symbol of India's success and unity. I have an emotional connection with the flag. Every morning while pinning the flag on my jacket, I am reminded of my responsibility with a sense of dedication to the country. We want to ensure the Tiranga is not just a symbol for holidays, but a living inspiration for the youth to uphold their rights and duties every single day," said Mr Naveen Jindal in a statement.

The Flag Foundation of India is utilising this milestone to advocate for January 23rd to be officially recognised as "National Flag Day." Through its "Right to Responsibility" initiative, the Foundation is expanding its mission beyond installation to include:

- Educational Outreach: Making the Tiranga relevant to the aspirations of modern Indian youth.
  - Environmental Stewardship: Promoting the respectful use, proper disposal, and recycling of flags.
  - National Pride: Encouraging citizens to fly the flag year-round as a personal commitment to nation-building.
- The Foundation invites all Indians to reconnect with the constitutional values the Tricolour represents—moving beyond the "right" to fly it toward the "responsibility" of living by the values it signifies.

इसी विचारधारा को संस्थागत

स्वरूप देते हुए फ्लैग फाउंडेशन ऑफ इंडिया की स्थापना की गई। आज यह संस्था देशभर में राष्ट्रीय ध्वज के सम्मान और संरक्षण के लिए अग्रणी भूमिका निभा रही है। वर्तमान में फ्लैग फाउंडेशन ऑफ इंडिया द्वारा देश के

विभिन्न हिस्सों में 200 विशालकाय तिरंगे स्थापित किए जा चुके हैं, जो न केवल देशभक्ति की भावना को जागृत करते हैं, बल्कि राष्ट्रीय एकता और गौरव का प्रतीक भी बन चुके हैं।

वर्ष 2026 का राष्ट्रीय ध्वज जागरूकता अभियान इसी यात्रा का अगला और अधिक व्यापक चरण है।

इस अभियान की शुरुआत कुरुक्षेत्र संसदीय क्षेत्र से की गई है, जहां से यह पहल पूरे हरियाणा और फिर चरणबद्ध रूप से देशभर में विस्तारित होगी। अभियान के अंतर्गत सेमिनार, कार्यशालाएँ, पदयात्राएँ, मेरथन, जनसंवाद और शैक्षणिक गतिविधियाँ आयोजित की जा रही हैं, ताकि विशेष रूप से युवाओं, विद्यार्थियों और आम नागरिकों को राष्ट्रीय ध्वज के इतिहास, ध्वज संहिता और उसके सम्मान से जुड़े नियमों की जानकारी दी जा सके। इस अभियान का एक महत्वपूर्ण पक्ष पुराने, क्षतिग्रस्त और खंडित हो चुके राष्ट्रीय ध्वजों का सम्मानजनक नवीनीकरण भी है। देशभर से ऐसे तिरंगों को एकत्रित कर उन्हें विधिसम्मत, गरिमापूर्ण और पर्यावरण के अनुकूल प्रक्रिया के

# Rally Behind the Flag

With geopolitical situation turning more complex and challenging for India, it's a clarion call for all hands on the deck, all citizens to rally behind the Tiranga, writes **Atanu Pattanayak**

**A**S Prime Minister Narendra Modi hoisted the Dharma Dhvaj atop the Ram Temple shikhara in Ayodhya on November 25, 2025, he said, 'This religious flag is not just a flag, it is the flag of the resurgence of Indian civilization'. A flag atop a temple can have so much reverberation, rekindling a spirit that has remained a timeless constant across geographies and history of the world. The PM's words provide a unique lens through which flags are not merely seen as colourful pieces of cloth, but as potent symbols that encapsulate the essence of ancient kingdoms and modern nation states and their people. Like religious flags, national flags symbolise a country's ethos, communicating unity, pride, and identity to its citizens and the global community.

National flags hold a special place for nation states as they serve as powerful symbols that represent a nation's identity, history, and values. Each flag carries a narrative that reflects the unique essence of its nation, influencing national pride and fostering connections across cultures. The Indian National Flag represents the hopes and aspirations of the people of India. It is the symbol of our national pride. Over the last eight decades, thousands of members of the armed forces have ungrudgingly laid down their lives to keep the tricolour flying in its full glory. In rallying behind the flag, we also honour and pay tribute to their supreme sacrifice.

Flags have also been a cornerstone of revolts, rebellions and uprisings, throwing out dictators and oppressive regimes, mobilising popular sentiments and rallying diverse groups under a single banner. Unfortunately, over the past decade or so, one flag has also come denote an exceptionally negative trend across the globe as the humanity confronts its gravest threat yet from fringe radical elements. From Montreal (Canada) to Mindanao (Philippines), ISIS's black flag, has become a central visual symbol of the group. The flag serves not merely as a religious emblem but as a strategic propaganda tool for Intra-Islamic legitimization and for global recruitment; propagating the flag through terror videos and social media fosters a sense of belonging to a global revolution.

In this backdrop of rising radical extremist terror, fracturing of the global financial and trade arrangements triggered by unilateral sanctions imposed on Russia after the Ukraine war, seizing \$300 billion assets held in western banks eroding trust in the USD as the global reserve currency and the unleashing of uncertain-

ties through unpredictable and vicious tariff wars and sanctions, there is an unprecedented churn in global geopolitics and geo-economics.

For India, the geopolitical situation has never been more complex and challenging. The year 2025 was a giant test in many ways as it had to navigate the geopolitical implications of the worst military conflict in decades with Pakistan, US

President Donald Trump's punitive 50% tariffs and increasingly troubled relations with Bangladesh. After Operation Sindoor, the US President has publicly embraced Pakistani leadership and cosied up with India's bete noire Asim Munir, hailing him as his 'favourite Field Marshal' and hosting him a lunch at the White House. Washington's new immigration policy and its decision to impose hefty H1B visa fees, abruptly cancels visa appointments, all contribute to the slide in India-US ties.

Bangladesh's increasing engagement with Pakistan and China have also contributed to the downturn in the security situation. The slide in the relations began soon after deposed prime minister Sheikh Hasina fled India in August 2024 in the face of a massive anti-government protest that ended her nearly 16-year rule. The relations have reached its nadir, with radical extremist elements cheering on as Hindus are lynched and their properties and temples set ablaze almost daily in Bangladesh.

The phenomena of illegal migration implicitly and directly facilitated by politicians of all hues, and facilitated by corrupt officials at all levels more interested in lining their pockets than serve the country have corroded the very fabric of our society. We as citizens are as much to blame for not raising our voice and accepting corruption as a way of life. We employ maids and menial workers without caring for their verification because

we can save some costs. Such callous attitude has now landed our country at a breaking point wherein if definite and resolute action are not taken by all citizens, India will become unrecognisable as we know her.

The sensitive and fragile situation is exacerbated by rampant corruption at all levels. There is a near breakdown of healthcare and education with private sector engaged in unethical profiteering with full complicity of officials and regulatory bodies. With millions of government jobs kept lying vacant and increasingly outsourced, the Gen Z is staring at a bleak future. Western corporate culture and influences have corroded the institutions of marriage, family and neighbourhoods. A course correction is urgent.

On December 29, 1943, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose raised the National Flag for the first time at the Gymkhana Ground (now Netaji Stadium) in Port Blair and proclaimed the Islands liberated from British control. The flag became our rallying point. The flag belongs to all of us, citizens. However, when a private individual, Sri Naveen Jindal wanted to fly the flag at his factory in Raigarh, he realised that he couldn't do so. His love for the Indian Flag had grown stronger in 1990s while studying in the US where he witnessed the American's passion for their flag, displaying their "Stars and Stripes" at all places, on every occasion and event of their daily life. A prolonged legal battle ensued.

On 23 January, 2004, which uncannily coincides with Netaji's birthday, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India ruled that flying of the National Flag is the Fundamental Right of an Indian citizen within Article 19 (1) (a) of the Constitution of India that grants freedom of speech and expression. Jindal's Flag Foundation of India has by now installed 170 monumental flagpoles across the country including a 207 feet monumental flagpole in the heart of the capital city, New Delhi.

On the occasion of Netaji's 129th birth anniversary on January 23, 2026, observed as the Parakram Diwas, we, the common citizens must resolve to work towards nation building and fightback all forms of threats to our nationhood, our Dharma, our way of life, our culture and our society.

It's a clarion call for all hands on the deck, all citizens to rally behind the tiranga.

## Flagging off a movement to recycle the *tiranga*

How the Flag Foundation of India wants to make the tricolour soar and retire gracefully

Twenty two years ago, industrialist-politician Naveen Jindal won a court battle that allowed every Indian the right to fly the *tiranga*. But with millions of flags now in use and with polyester added to the permissible fabric, comes the question of respectful disposal of the worn-out flags. That's where the Flag Foundation of India's (FFOI) effort to recycle the flag comes in.

On Saturday, at Jindal House in Delhi, an event was held to mark the anniversary of the Supreme Court judgment that democratised the use of the national flag and also to felicitate India's visually impaired women's cricket team that won the T20 World Cup recently. As guests left the delightful luncheon where top

cops, lawyers, politicians, former Generals and academicians mingled and shared nostalgic stories of the landmark case, everyone was gifted a recycled flag.

### GREEN INITIATIVE

"Now that the common public has got the right to fly flags and the usage has been expanded beyond khadi, cotton and silk to include polyester, the question arises — how do you dispose it? That's why we said, let us start a drive to

recycle the flags," says Major General Ashim Kohli, CEO of FFOI, describing how the foundation approached IIT-Delhi to come up with a technology to do so. Interestingly, Maj Gen Kohli, with his daughter, runs an NGO — Sewaj Niseem Foundation — that has a '*Vardi ka Samman*' initiative to gracefully dispose of uniforms used by defence personnel. "With the approval of the Army headquarters, we started this movement," he says, describing how over 35,000

to 40,000 uniforms have been collected and repurposed. This year, they plan to scale up the initiative.

Meanwhile, the Jindals — Naveen and Shalu — who are President and Vice President of FFOI, are keeping the momentum around '*har ghar tiranga*' going with awareness campaigns.

FFOI is seeking recognition of January 23 as National Flag Day, and Shalu Jindal describes how there is an idea to create a flag museum. After all, the Jindals are sitting on some marvellous treasures around the *tiranga*, such as a lot of original commissioned audio tributes from composers like Vanraj Bhatta and singers like Soma Nigam and Shreya Ghoshal.

"The album was called '*Tiranga Mera Aanchal*', and I would love to relaunch it," she says.
